Annual General Meeting

Michael was elected as a life member so congratulation for this prestigious recognition by our Club for the role you have played at Beaumont over the years.

Membership Fees

One of the changes to our fees highlighted at the AGM was the cost of an Associate Member dropping from \$200 to \$65. I have already chatted to 2 *Night Owlers* who are going to join at this fee. A letter will now be sent to all *Night Owlers* informing them of the change and encouraging them to join.

It was clear during the discussion about fees for new members (men and women) that it may be time for the Board to discuss some of the issues raised at the meeting around this topic. It is important that everything relating to our fees is transparent.

Club Closure

Just a reminder that our Club will be closed from Monday 16 May until Thursday 19 May as the Council will be replacing our roof. This means that social bowls will be cancelled on the Wednesday. We have developed a good relationship with the Burnside Council and your Board will ensure that this relationship continues to prosper.

Happy Hours

Raising much needed funds will also continue to be a priority, so our Happy Hours will start again on Friday 27 May. Drink prices will be reduced from 5:30pm until 6:30pm and each week there will be a member's draw of \$50 which will increase by \$10 each week if the member drawn on the night is not present.

Every menu will consist of 2 courses; a main and a dessert. You will be offered casseroles, curries, prawns and calamari, lasagne, schnitzel, etc and desserts such as apricot and ginger cream, tiramisu, chocolate and almond cake, trifles.....and the list goes on. This is rather an ambitious menu for us but we are going to give it a go. Sometime during the Winter, work will begin on our kitchen......so fingers crossed there will be minimum disruption to our Happy Hours.

> There will be an important proviso for Happy Hours this year because we will be asking members to pre-book. This will ensure that we don't waste food, time and money with over-catering. We know you will appreciate why we need to do this so a good idea might be to cross out every Friday night in your diary now. Whist this was a great fundraiser last year, it was also a great time for
