Budget

Our goal is to update and modernise our clubrooms as much and as soon as possible, with the aim to significantly increase the

number of people who hire our facilities. This way, long term sustainability will be assured. I actually met a member from a small club the other day and asked them how their club finances were going and he said there wasn't a problem because of how many people hired their facilities. We will be working hard to increase our number of night owlers this year and the recent support for our Happy Hours has been fantastic. The weather has not been kind to our social bowls for a while which is disappointing.

Your 2016/17 subscription will be sent to you shortly and will be due by Wednesday 31 August. As you know, Bowls SA has increased the capitation fee by \$4 which will not be added to your fees this year. The Club will be picking this up on your behalf.
