Hi everyone

Your Board met for its final meeting on Monday night before our **AGM** on **Friday 5 May** at **7pm**. As you will see from our update, there are some important issues that will be discussed at the meeting so we hope many of you already have this date in your diary.

Membership Fees

Let me start with some good news....

After reviewing our finances last night, the Board has changed the recommendation re an increase in our membership fees and will now be seeking an increase of **only \$5.00** rather than the \$10.00 previously mentioned. This \$5.00 will cover the \$3.00 capitation fee increase by Bowls SA last year. If you remember, the Club covered this cost for you last season. This will take the annual membership fee to \$305.00.



All other types of membership would also increase by \$5.00, eg Associate Membership would increase from \$65.00 to \$70.00.

This recommended increase will be presented at the AGM.

Toilet Upgrade

This will also be an item that we would like to discuss at the AGM that members are fully SO informed about the extent of the problems with our toilets (both male and female), the estimated cost to upgrade them, the plans presented to us by a range of "specialists", the Burnside City Council's involvement. our submission to the Office of Recreation and Sport and a feasible timeline if we gain, in principle, support from you to proceed. Another reason to come along to the AGM....

Disability Car Parks

Ian Campbell and I met with a representative from the Burnside City Council to discuss the need for two disability car parking spots by the gate. The need for these became evident when a wheelchair bowler played at our Club and couldn't access a park close to the gate. The Council is looking into this.

Bar times over the autumn / winter break

Please note that our Bar will only provide bar service for social bowls



during the pennant off season. Bar service will also be provided for any function held at the Club eg Happy Hours. There will not be service at any other time. I'm sure you will all agree that our wonderful Bar Managers and helpers deserve a break. Please also note that no alcohol can be purchased on Good Friday due to licence restrictions.

Social Bowls

For those who have been playing Social Bowls, there has been a slight change in the format to accommodate odd numbers of players and to ensure that we have one competition rather than one of Triples and Pairs on some days. This will also avoid the need for a person to sometimes stand out and not get a game.

The change is that all teams will have the same number of bowls whether it is a Triple or a Pair ie 8 bowls per team. So, if there needs to be a mixture of Pairs and Triples, Skippers bowling in a Triple will only have 2 bowls. We feel this is a good challenge for these people as they are usually our more experienced bowlers. If the numbers work out on the day to be all Triples then obviously everyone will have 3 bowls.

We would like to trial this for a season to see if it provides the necessary flexibility for our

organisers to plan the teams right up to the cut-off point.

As you know, we are having another Garage Sale on **Saturday 6 May and Sunday 7 May** at our Club so if you have quality bric-abrac, please feel free to start bringing it to the Club. We will store it in the room outside the women's toilet or the paint shed.
