#### **Future of Our Greens**

If you remember last year approval was obtained at the December Board meeting to undertake:

- 1. Core sampling and a geotechnical report on the sub-soil under "B" Green; and
- 2. Contact the Waite Institute to profile "B" Green soil and lawn to assess the extent of fungal diseases in the samples and provide a report on the findings along with recommendations for treatment.

These are two separate tasks and contacts have been made with the relevant organisations to see if we can complete these tasks by the end of January. These reports will assist the *Future of Our Greens* committee to continue their discussions about "where to next" with our greens. We will of course keep you informed about our progress.

## **Fund My Neighbourhood**

We are currently having plans developed for our toilets and we will also be including the disability toilet and entrances to the toilets. These plans will be displayed once they are ready. We have yet another submission to complete by February 16 so a contract can be drawn up. The money from the project is then expected to flow from April.
