New Shirts

We haven't forgotten that the majority of members would like to see new shirts but the Board has given up on the predominantly yellow ones (I can hear a few cheers) and two Board members with some contacts are going to see if they will help us out to come up with a new design. Why don't some of you have a go? That is how Walkerville designed their new shirts. We agreed we would still like white, blue and yellow to feature. Get your creative juices flowing over the break.

Facilities

The Board has three major priorities:

- 1. A new watering system.
- 2. To replace our greens lighting to LED and replace two of the poles which do not fold when work is needed to be done.
- 3. Fixed metal shades at the back of all the greens.

Hopefully, number 1 will be decided on Monday night.

There are now several grants we can apply for the lighting and the shades and the submissions are due on January 21. The lighting is going to cost around \$32,000 and the shades around \$180,000 (structure, demolition and water run off). The grants require applicants to pay fifty percent of the costs so you can see that this makes the shading structures out of our reach unless we can find other support. We have written to the Burnside Council to see if they would contribute and we are waiting to hear back from them. If the shading is not possible, we will write a submission for the lighting.

The grants are going to be made available next year as well so we may have to have a big fund-raising year again!!!!! Fingers crossed.

Fencing

A few years ago, a car ran into our fence along Hay Street and of course did not stop. It does look ugly and we have received one quote of around \$4,000 to replace the fence. We will keep you posted on that one (a nice pun).

Footbridge

Thank you to **Angelo Beltrame** for replacing the footbridge on the side of the A green. The wooden bridge had deteriorated to a point where it was not safe. Typical of Angelo, the time and materials were donated. One day Angelo there will be a goat in the club!
