



“Dear Members,

Further to the MBA policy requirement for all Pennant players to be double vaccinated in order to play bowls, the Board met last night and it was determined that ALL visitors to the club (includes clubhouse & outside areas) must be at least double vaccinated & must provide proof of same prior to entry.

This NO JAB – NO ENTRY policy will take effect as of midnight Monday 17th January.

We are progressively contacting our regular hall hirers & night owlers to advise them of the new policy. In the meantime we would ask that you advise any family, friends & acquaintances accordingly.

Whilst we acknowledge that the introduction of this policy may cause some inconvenience to some people, we believe that we have a duty of care to protect the health & wellbeing of not only you the members, but all concerned.

At present we are restricted to certain numbers within the clubhouse & on the front veranda. These numbers are clearly indicated on the entry doors.

We ask that you strictly adhere to these numbers at all times including the wearing of masks inside the clubhouse unless seated eating /and or drinking.

Whilst we can manage the restricted numbers on pennant days by way of separate mid-game breaks, night owls is far more problematic.

To this end, we have delayed the re-commencement of night owls until at least the 1st February (a separate email will be sent to all night owlers advising them of this).

At this stage we are still planning on re-opening the Bistro on Thursday 3rd February.
