On & Around the Greens (Dennis Reid)

Again there has been minimal activity in respect of cutting and rolling. With little growth during these past couple of months the greens have only been cut once in the last four weeks and rolling mostly occurring only on the days of actual social bowls. I am sure that this hasn't impacted at all on the playing surfaces.

We have only had to close the greens on one of the social days due to heavy rainfall. There will be some closures of the greens on other days if we get some heavy downpours and if spraying is required. Please keep checking the green allocation board before rolling up.

We will continue with C Green being used for the majority of roll ups and social bowling. You would have noticed that some rinks are being closed on this green in order to offer protection to the playing surface which has been impacted by the amount of rain. We will continue playing mostly East/West in the next few weeks.

James has continued with spraying of all greens with the purpose of containing winter weeds and moss. All greens look in good order at this time of the year.

Indoor Bowling Mats

We now have two near new indoor bowling mats which were used for the first time Friday 21st July. We are just having a few issues with the indoor bowls. Unfortunately the four second hand sets we purchased with the mats are wide swinging bowls which are hard to keep on the mats. Jenny Tregoning has sourced a couple of sets of the correct bowls & Viv Leaker is looking into getting another two sets so hopefully when social bowls are cancelled due to weather we can all come inside & keep bowling. Who knows, we may be able to get some indoor bowling competitions up & running in due course. Watch this space!
